All Senior Team Captains of Streatham & Marlborough CC will:

- Comply at all times with the club's Code of Conduct for members and volunteers
- By both their words and actions, encourage and remind members of their team to comply with the Code of Conduct for members

in each case especially in relation to:

- Actively discouraging unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials
- Recognising good performance and effort, not just match results
- Treating everyone equally
- Not condoning, or allowing to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Act as an ambassador for the club, representing and upholding its values
- Foster a friendly and supportive team atmosphere where everyone is listened to, respected and treated fairly
- Ensure the well-being and support of their team members throughout the season
- Be clear and respectful in all dealings with the opposition
- Comply with the club's selection policies and attend selection meetings when required
- Encourage and remind members of their team to use the relevant methods (currently Teamo) to mark their availability and pay match fees
- Always work in an open environment (i.e. avoid private, or unobserved, situations) in particular with any under 18s but also more generally, balancing this with any confidentiality concerns
- Ensure any vice-captain or other team member takes on your match responsibilities for any game they cannot attend
- Encourage the team to attend training sessions
- Undertake any necessary vetting procedures, including holding a clear DBS certificate
